John Deere Model "B" General Purpose

THE John Deere Model "B" General Purpose is proving the ideal power unit for operators of relatively small, general farms where the power requirements are not great enough to employ a tractor of larger size. It is adaptable to do all manner of work that a small tractor would be called upon to do, including all kinds of planting and cultivating in row crops, even to truck gardening.

Another group of larger farm operators, already using large tractors, are adding John Deere Model "B" Tractors to do some of the lighter, miscellaneous operations that are not so well adapted to a larger tractor. These farms can utilize the two tractors to advantage because there is plenty of work for both.

All the Modern Features

The Model "B" is about two-thirds the size of the Model "A" in power and weight, but has all of the advanced John Deere General-Purpose features . . . adjustable rear wheel tread . . . four forward speeds . . . narrow, compact design . . . light weight. It is a revelation in its bed-rock economy of operation . . . its amazing ease of handling.

It is a general purpose tractor in every sense of the word, with all that the name "John Deere" on tractors means . . . simplicity . . . quality construction . . . dependability . . . easy access to all parts. It is easy to keep in good running order.

Like the Model "A", the Model "B" is equipped with power shaft for operating power take-off machines and can be equipped with hydraulic power lift for raising and lowering integral working equipment.

It is big in power for its size—it has the pulling capacity of a four horse team, and the daily work output of 6 to 8 horses.

Rubber Tires

The Model "B" can be furnished with special rear wheels and 9.00 x 36" or 7.50 x 36" low-pressure rubber tires and tubes; special front wheels with 5.00 x 15" low-pressure tires and tubes.

Skeleton Wheels

The Model "B" is shown at the right equipped with skeleton-type rear wheels—favorite equipment in many sections where the soil is firm or hard.
